TENTS: All tents shall have some type of Flame Retardant or Resistant Certificate (TAG or PAPERWORK) on-site and/or submitted to the Bureau prior to the event. Shade canopies smaller than 10x10 without sides may be approved for use on a case by case basis. No smoking allowed in any tent.		STORAGE: Use or handling of flammable liquids or gases shall be prohibited at the site unless specifically approved and inspected by the Bureau.
COOKING TENTS: Tents are allowed to have cooking (APPROVED APPLIANCES) along the outer edges of the tent. LP gas tanks must be secured in place (max cap 20lbs.) Fire Extinguisher must be readily available. Any LP tanks larger than		FLOOR/DECOR: No hay, straw, shavings or similar materials shall be permitted to be used within any structure, tent or canopy. Tents with an occupant load of over 49 require a minimum of 2 exits.		COOKING: All food cooking concession trucks, trailers, and structures of rigid construction are required to have a currently tagged commercial ventilation and extinguishment/suppression systems if required per the FFPC and NFPA 96.
